Some of the classes are also approved for continuing education (CE) credit as required by the New Jersey Real Estate Commission (NJREC)*.

*Continuing Education (CE) is a requirement by the New Jersey Real Estate Commission (REC) for real estate licensees in New Jersey. Licensees are reminded that to be eligible to renew their license for the 2025-2027 license term they will need to have acquired a total of 12 credit-hours of continuing education, including at least six in Core topics, of which at least two must be in Ethics.
